



## 11th Summit of Heads of State and Government of the OACPS Malabo, 27-29 March 2026

### **Subject : Exclusive Interview - Moussa Batraki, Secretary-General of the OACPS ahead of the Malabo Summit**

The 11th Summit of OACPS Heads of State and Government, to be held on **28-29 March 2026 in Malabo**, will be far more than a commemoration of the Organisation's 50th anniversary. It will mark a deliberate strategic shift:

- transition from a traditional North-South aid paradigm toward sustainable private investment, notably in **infrastructure, green energy, education**;
- renewed drive to strengthen intra-regional trade and South-South cooperation;
- Deep institutional reforms aimed at greater transparency and financial autonomy;
- Concrete responses to three major global challenges: climate change, the digital divide, and rising inequalities.

Under the leadership of its new Secretary-General, **Mr. Moussa Batraki of Chad, in office since March 2025**, the OACPS seeks to position itself as a sovereign and influential actor in 21st-century multilateralism, while diversifying its partnerships beyond the European Union framework (Samoa agreement).

Malabo 2026 therefore offers a unique perspective: that of a 79-member organisation representing 1.2 billion people, determined to transform long-standing structural vulnerabilities into levers of geopolitical and economic influence.
